Minimum Amounts must be at least 1/4 oz. When crediting such combination products toward the MMA, the amount of MMA/serving in the product is the determining factor not the total portion size. Product analysis sheet must state the amount of cooked lean MMA/serving and serving size. MMA include lean meat, poultry, fish, cheese, egg; yogurt, cooked dry beans or peas; nuts and seeds and their butters (except for acorn, chestnut and coconut); or an equivalent quantity to any combination of these foods. Cooked dried beans or peas cannot be credited as a MMA & credited as a VFJ in the same item and/or meal. Alternate (formerly TVP) Protein products, the current regulations remove the restrictions (1); that APP must be fortified with vitamins and minerals and (2) that no more than 30% of the MMA component be APP; up to 100% APP may now meet the MMA component. Alternative Protein products will resemble cooked meat, poultry, or fish. Nuts and seeds may fulfill no more than 1/2 of the MMA requirement for lunch.

Grain/Bread Products (GB)

List Grain Ingredients and wgt in 1 serving Whole Wheat 22.5g Enriched Flour 18g

Criteria for crediting GB: (1). Must be made from enriched or whole grains. Cereals may also be fortified, (2). The label must state it is enriched or whole-grain. If it is enriched, it must meet FDA standards for enrichment, (3). Must meet the criteria for the minimum serving size of 1/4 serving.

CALCULATIONS FOR CREDIT - A food item must contain no less than 14.75 grams or 0.52 ounces of enriched or whole-grain meal and/or flour to be considered a full serving of grains/breads. Amount grain used in ounces (or grams) DIVIDE by the number of servings produced by the recipe. Then divide .52 ounces (or 14.75g) (the amount of grain needed to contribute 1 grain/bread serving). Result is the number of GB servings per portion.

Note: if dry cereal is used in the recipe, one serving credited for each 3/4 cup or 1 ounce serving. 1 serving cooked cereal credited for each 1/2 cup serving of cooked product or 25 grams (.9 oz.) dry product.

Vegetable/Fruit/Juice Product(VFJ)

List VFJ ingredient & volume in 1 serving _____

In order to be creditable, a juice must contain a minimum of 50% full-strength juice and then, only the full-strength juice portion may be counted to meet the VFJ requirement. If less than full strength juice is used, the volume of liquid must be adjusted and credited based on a full strength equivalent. As of November 24, 1997, policy is revised to require that all fruit juices must be pasteurized. Some kinds of juice and cider have not been pasteurized. Frozen fruit bars must state the amount of 100% fruit juice is contained in each serving. Cooked dried beans or peas may be counted either as a VFJ or as a MMA but not as both in the same meal or food item. Vegetables and fruits are credited as served. In order to count for crediting purposes minimum of 1/8 cup VFJ per serving is required. Breaded vegetables must list the amount of VFJ and GB per serving separately.
